This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondent not to seal unit of petitioners in SCO No.40, Sector 7-C, Madhya Marg, Chandigarh and separate Id's of the petitioners for fiscal purposes may be created. Further a prayer has been made for quashing the order dated 05.09.2018 (Annexure P-5) qua the petitioners.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to take recourse to the alternative remedies as available to them, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies, as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
