The petitioner has chosen to question clause 13(vii) of the Notice Inviting Tender dated 27.07.2017 at this belated stage when admittedly the contract period itself is nearing to expire on 31.03.2018.

In our considered view, when tender has already floated; work allotted and such allotted work is nearing completion, the instant writ petition is liable to be dismissed on the ground of delay and laches.

Ordered accordingly.

However, if the petitioner is aggrieved by any condition of the subsequent Notice Inviting Tender, he shall be at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.
