Through the instant petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought an issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count his service with Punjab Warehousing Corporation w.e.f. 16.05.1979 to 23.12.1980 for the purpose of grant of pensionary benefits and to revise his pension as well as to grant arrears of revised pension and to pay all consequential benefits along with interest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a representation was made to the respondents on 04.06.2018 (P-10) but no final decision has been taken by the concerned authorities till date. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the above said representation (P-10) in a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 04.06.2018 (P-10) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feel aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authorities, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
