By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance direction to the official respondents to take action on the complaint/representation dated 13.4.2018 (Annexure P-4).

There is written request for adjournment circulated on behalf of the petitioner. However, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that at this stage she would be satisfied in case the respondent No.2-Director Rural Development and Panchayats, Govt. of Punjab is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 13.4.2018 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director Rural Development and Panchayats, Govt. of Punjab to consider and decide the representation dated 13.4.2018 (Annexure P-4) within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In

case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
