Reply has been filed in Court today . The same is taken
on record.

The claim in the present writ petition is for the release of
the pensionary benefits. In the reply, counsel for the State in
paragraph 2 has stated that all the retiral benefits were paid to the
petitioner immediately on his retirement. With regard to the request
of the petitioner for re-fixing his salary and revising his pensionary
benefits, the same has also been granted to the petitioner vide order
dated 10.03.2016 along with interest @ 18% per annum. A total sum
of ₹1,60,822/- has already been paid to the petitioner after revising

his salary.

The petitioner prays that he is entitled for the interest. In fact, counsel for the respondents in paragraph 1 has already mentioned that the payments were made with interest @ 18%.

In view of the above, no claim of the petitioner survives for any other benefit and the petition has been rendered infructuous.

The present writ petitiion is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. In case, the petitioner has any other grievance, he is at liberty to file a representation with the respondents in respect of the same.
