RAKESH KUMAR JAIN, J. (ORAL)

The learned counsel for the University has submitted that even the University has taken certain decisions in this case, namely, i) the petitioner would be marked present from the date of enforcement of restraint order dated 07.08.2018 till date, ii) The SHC and the University have extended full support to ensure that there would be no impediments in his academic performance and smooth integration of the petitioner into the classes, iii) the faculty would extend additional help to make up for missed classes and internal examinations, iv) the suspension order is not punitive and v) Remarks “uninvited verbal sexual advances” may be expunged.

It is further submitted by the counsel for the University that the order of suspension would enure only for a week and

order of probation would be over by 31.12.2018 and all adverse remarks against the petitioner would automatically come to an end and it would not be kept in the personal file of the petitioner so as to save his future.

The stand taken by the respondent-University is accepted by the counsel for the petitioner after consultation with her client and his parents, who are present in the Court.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of.
