JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (*Gurinder Singh*) claims himself to be the grand-son of the freedom fighter. The grievance is that inspite of reservation of one *per cent* (1%) of Class-III posts in various departments of State of Punjab, no recruitment has been made to such posts by advertising and considering the competing claims under that category.

This Court had directed the learned State Counsel, Mrs. Anu Chatrath Kapur, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, to seek instructions primarily from the Irrigation Department *qua* whom the legal notice had been issued.

Learned State Counsel states that the legal notice of the petitioner had been earlier replied on 03.07.2015. She further states that the Government of Punjab has issued instructions, which have been appended in the writ petition, providing for one *per cent* (1%) reservation, whereby the departments are bound to provide reservation at the time of advertisement as per the instructions.

Keeping in view the nature of the relief claimed, no further directions are required to be issued.
