This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.3 to recover the loan amount, given by it to respondent No.4 by selling the property of respondent No.4, as is also mentioned in order dated 27.10.2014 passed by the Debts Recovery Tribunal-II, Chandigarh and not to harass the petitioners and further to release the properties of the petitioners, which the petitioners have mortgaged against their own limit account and house loan account as the petitioners are ready to clear their own entire loan amount and further directing respondent No.3 to accept the loan amount from the

petitioners and to issue no due certificate to them and release their properties.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail the alternative remedies as are available to them in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be, available to them, in accordance with law.
