On instructions from the petitioner, learned counsel makes a categorical statement that the petitioner would pay back entire amount disbursed to him, towards allowance for third child, to the department.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that some amount has been recovered from him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further makes a statement that he will pay back the entire remaining amount with an interest of 8% p.a. within three months from today with a cost of Rs.5,000/- to the respondent.

Statement is accepted. If the amounts as above, are not deposited with interest and cost, the same shall be recovered from the petitioner's salary in two equal installments.

In view of the above, Civil Writ Petition is disposed of.
