Application is allowed as prayed for and copy of order dated 27.07.2018 (P-11) is taken on record subject to all just exceptions and be tagged at appropriate place.

Main Case

By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought an issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the inaction on the part of the respondents of not releasing arrears of salaries and retiral benefits due to him WITH FURTHER to release the arrears of salaries from 15.07.2016 to 03.05.2018 and all retiral benefits along with interest @ 18% p.a.

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2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a representation was made to the respondent No.2 on 20.07.2018 (P-9) but till date no conscious decision has been taken thereon. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the above said representation (P-9), in a time bound manner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 20.07.2018 (P-9) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
