Petitioner by way of present writ petition has sought issuance of direction in the nature of writ of Certiorari seeking quashing of the impugned letter dated 23.07.2015 (**P-6**) and also the letter/order dated 08.02.2016 (**P-10**) passed by respondent no.1 directing the respondent no.2 to initiate proceedings for compulsory retirement of the petitioner.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition has become infructuous as the petitioner had retired from service on 31.01.2017 to which learned Counsel for the respondents concedes.

In view of the above, present writ petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
