KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

The petitioner is aggrieved owing to inaction of the respondent authorities, for, despite having been awarded a transportation contract for cluster Sultanpur Lodhi, as also a labour and cartage contract of food grains, he has not been assigned the work under Atta-Dal Scheme, for which the contract was awarded in his favour. It is urged that the petitioner had complied with all the terms and conditions subject to which he was appointed as a transportation contractor as also a contractor for labour and cartage. And, prior to the institution of this petition, he had even served the respondents with a representation, dated 24.8.2018 (Annexure P-5), as regards his grievance. But to no avail. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondent authorities to consider and decide his representation within specified time.

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That being so, the petition is disposed of, with a direction to the respondent authorities to consider and deal with the representation, alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner and is pending consideration, within a period of two weeks from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. Needless to assert that the respondent authorities shall pass a comprehensive order, in accordance with law, assigning reasons in support thereof.
