KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

Concededly, as of now, respondent No.2 has since been adjudged as L-1 for awarding handling and transport contract for Shahabad. However, the grievance of the petitioner is that since respondent No.2, was technically non-compliant, his technical bid ought to have been rejected by the respondents-authorities. If that be so, in our view the petitioner ought to have moved the respondents in the first instance.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw this petition so as to enable the petitioner to file a representation to the respondents-authorities as regards his grievance and ineligibility of respondent No.2 to participate in the tender process. And, in the event any such representation is filed the same be dealt with within a specified time.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

This Court is sanguine that if the petitioner indeed moves any such representation, as indicated above, the respondents-authorities shall deal therewith within a week from the date of its receipt and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.
