Rule heard forthwith with the consent of counsel for the rival parties.

This Court had made an order dated 07.09.2016, which reads thus:-

“Since one of the relief claimed by the petitioner pertains to Rule 23 of Haryana Superior Judicial Service Rules, 2007, namely, benefit of practice at the bar before joining the service or for a period of ten years, whichever is less, towards

qualifying service' for pension and other retiral benefits, we direct the State of Haryana to reconsider such claim in the light of ibid Rule and take a fresh decision before the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 17.11.2016.”

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, now counsel for the State as well as counsel for the High Court have placed on record a decision taken by the State Government. The said communication is taken on record and is marked as “X” for identification, which shall be the part and parcel of the record. We have gone through the communication filed by the learned State counsel. We think that the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed by way of said communication dated 19/24.09.2017 of the State Government, which has been agreed upon by learned counsel for the petitioner as well. We therefore find that the petition is required to be disposed of in terms of communication letter dated 19/24.09.2017 of the State Government.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
