The impugned order has been passed by the Estate Officer, Punjab State Agricultural Marketing Board at Amritsar, *inter-alia*, holding that the petitioners are not entitled to seek allotment of plot in Fish Market, Amritsar on reserve price under the Punjab State Agricultural Marketing Board (Sale and Transfer of Plots) Rules, 1999 as the allotment has been made through public auction by fixing minimum reserve price. The cited Rules have been formulated in exercise of powers under the Punjab Agricultural Produce Markets Act, 1961 and these Rules contain an express provision to file appeal against the order of Estate Officer before the Chief Administrator of Mandi Board. Though there is delay on the part of the petitioners, however, in the interest of justice, they are permitted to file appeal within a period of one months from today. If the petitioners file the appeal(s), let the same be decided on merits and in accordance with law.
