RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (Oral)

1. Copy of the service book has been produced in Court. This settles the dispute as to its existence.

2. It will now be for the petitioner to approach the Civil Court to address his grievance as there is a dispute regarding date of birth of the petitioner which can be more appropriately dealt with by the Civil Court.

3. The petition is disposed of with the above liberty.

4. As far as the service benefits are concerned taking the date of birth as 08.04.1956, the same be disbursed subject to fulfilling the formalities by the petitioner and to the final declaration as to his date of birth by Court of law. Delay, if any, in disbursement of benefits will also remain subject to the decision by the Civil court and whether any

interest is payable or not and at what rate will be for the trial Court to decide. From the time the petitioner concludes the formalities of paperwork, the non-disputed dues will be disbursed to him within three months from the date of receiving of the certified copy of the order.
