It comes out that petitioner has filed an application dated 1.9.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Section 3(1) (c) and Section 2(c) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for parole for a period of six weeks for agricultural operations. No speaking order on the same has been passed.

In the circumstance, petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass the speaking order on the application dated 1.9.2018 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner. It is further directed that the Commissioner, Faridabad Division, Faridabad before passing the order shall give hearing to the counsel for the petitioner, if he so desires, so that relevant law on the point may be brought to the notice within the time frame as per the Government instructions.
