By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of impugned order dated 14.09.1999 (Annexure P-2) forfeiting the regular service of two years with permanent effect for the purpose of annual increment of the petitioner and orders dated 14.01.2005, 26.05.2005 and 20.02.2006 (Annexures P-3 to P-5) respectively.

Learned counsel states that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case respondents are directed to consider and decide the appeal dated 21.08.2006 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider and decide the appeal dated 21.08.2006 (Annexure P-6). In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that

the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of three months thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
