This petition is filed for seeking a direction to respondent No. 1 to provide a copy of the order to the petitioner, passed by the Director of Industries & Commerce-cum-Registrar General of Societies, Haryana in appeal No. 227/RGSH which was announced on 29.05.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had filed an appeal in terms of Section 79 of the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012 (for short 'the Act') before the State Registrar against the order dated 17.05.2017 passed by the District Registrar whereby approval has been given to the newly elected Governing Body of the Society. The said appeal was allowed in favour of the petitioner on 15.03.2018. The private respondents challenged the order of appeal by filing further appeal in terms of Section 79 of the Act before the Registrar General. It is further submitted that though the Registrar General has announced the order in the appeal on 29.05.2018 as "Allowed" but so far the copy of the order has not been given to the petitioner so that the petitioner may, challenge the same in accordance with law. The petitioner has thus had to approach this Court for the said purpose.

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I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record with his able assistance.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances narrated hereinabove, I do not find any necessity to issue notice to the respondents as this petition can be disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 1 to handover a copy of the order passed/announced by him on 29.05.2018 so that the petitioner may, if still feel aggrieved, challenge the same in accordance with law.

Needful shall be done by respondent No. 1 within a period of 15 days' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
