By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought an issuance of a writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the amount of Rs.7,31,058/- on account of gratuity along with interest thereon to him.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though legal notice dated 18.07.2018 (P-2) was served upon the respondents but till date no conscious action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent Nos.2 & 3 to decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-2), within some specified period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 18.07.2018 (P-2) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
