This order will dispose of CWP No.4221 of 2016, *M/s National Fertilizers Ltd. v. R.M.S. Kundu and another* & CWP No.28000 of 2017, *R.M.S Kundu v. National Fertilizer Ltd. and another*.

After hearing Mr. Talwar for the petitioner-management and Mr. RMS Kundu in person for a considerable length of time and the apparent soundness of the findings of the Presiding Officer, Labour Court, Panipat in his award challenged in these cross petitions, the matter has been

amicably resolved in the presence of Mr. Dinesh Sood, General Manager, HR Corporate Office, NFL, Noida with his undertaking that the management would pay ₹45 lac to Mr. RMS Kundu as full and final settlement of the disputes. The amount will be paid by a bank draft in the name of Mr. RMS Kundu within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Mr. Kundu would have no further claims against the management on any account and management will be bound by this consent order. This amicably settles the dispute to the satisfaction of both the parties.

The petitions stand disposed of.
