By way of the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the respondents to hold an inquiry into the illegal allotment of 5 marla plots to the persons who were not at all eligible and were having palatial houses and to decide the representation dated 21.07.2017 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case the present petition is treated as a representation and respondent No.2 is directed to decide the same expeditiously.

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat, Vikas Bhawan, Sector-62 SAS Nagar, Mohali to treat the present petition as a representation and pass an appropriate order as per law after hearing all the parties concerned within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order along with copy of writ petition.
