The petitioner is employed as Driver with the respondent-department. Vide order dated 08.06.2017 (Annexure P1), he was transferred from Bhiwani to Jhajjar vice Sh. Vimaljeet Driver No.68. However, on a writ petition filed by Vimaljeet i.e. CWP No.16501 of 2017, this Court vide an interim order dated 28.07.2017 stayed the operation of the order Annexure P1. As a result, vide order dated 03.08.2017 (Annexure P2), the order of transfer of Sh. Vimaljeet Driver was withdrawn by the respondent-department. And the petitioner was consequently relieved from Jhajjar so as to join duties at Bhiwani. Concededly, in compliance to the impugned order the petitioner as also Sh. Vimaljeet have joined at their previous postings. And the order being assailed in the present proceedings was passed over six months ago. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as in the matter involving similar issues, as regards transfer of the employees of the Transport Department, Haryana, this Court vide order and judgment

dated 01.09.2017 (Annexure P6), as also the judgment dated 12.12.2017, rendered in CWP No.24190 of 2017 (**Dilbag Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others**), had issued comprehensive directions to the department to deal with similar issues, he be permitted to withdraw the petition so as to move the respondent-authorities vide a detailed representation.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty prayed for.

In the event, the petitioner makes any such representation the same shall be considered and dealt with by the respondent-authorities expeditiously and in accordance with law.
