AJAY KUMAR MITTAL, J.

1. The prayer made in the writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for quashing the demand notice dated 19.6.2018, Annexure P.3, issued by respondent No.1 as well as the notice dated 7.9.2018, Annexure P.5, by virtue of which the respondent-Bank is threatening to take over the actual physical possession of the only residential house of the petitioner on 17.9.2018, which is in violation of the statutory provisions of law.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that she may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the Bank at the first instance or to take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
