JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of direction to the official respondents to suspend the Sarpanch of village Sikhopur, Tehsil Manesar, District Gurugram as he is involved in corrupt practices and embezzled the government funds and to stop the disbursement of government funds to the Panchayat, village Shikhopur; and to appoint the committee for management of the financial transactions of Panchayat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2- Deputy Commissioner, Gurugram to consider and decide the representation/ letter dated 28.5.2018 (Annexure P-5) expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Kapil Bansal, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the paper book

has been supplied to him in the Court.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.

2- Deputy Commissioner, Gurugram to consider and decide the representation/ letter dated 28.5.2018 (Annexure P-5) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
