Petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to grant them pay, promotion, ACP Scales, Leave, Govt. Gazette holidays and monthly rest of four days along with all other statutory benefits, which are available under the Punjab Civil Service Rules (As applicable to Haryana) at par with other similarly situated “Group D” employees recruited under the Haryana Forest Department (Group D) Service Rules, 1998.

Upon notice, affidavit dated 23.05.2017 of Divisional Wildlife Officer, Rohtak, Haryana on behalf of respondent No.4 has been filed. Along with the affidavit, copy of order dated 19.05.2017 has been placed on record as Annexure R-1. As per this order, petitioners have been regularized as labourers under a diminishing cadre, as posts of labourers are created from time to time and their posts are not permanent. Whenever a labourer,

be abolished. However, all the persons occupying the posts of labourers have been extended the benefit of ACP, leave of all kinds (including casual, medical earned leave etc.) and weekly rest, other than the avenue for promotion as there does not exist any rule providing for their promotions.

Keeping in view that major relief has already been granted to the petitioners, no further direction is required to be given in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
