The petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 13.12.2016 passed by respondent No.3 by which her application for grant of compensation in terms of the provisions of Rajiv Gandhi Pariwar Bima Yojna [for short 'the Scheme'] has been declined on the ground that the application has been moved after the period of six months.

Since the petitioner is claiming compensation in terms of the Scheme, therefore, she is also bound by the other provisions of the Scheme in which there is a provision of appeal to the Director, Social Justice & Empowerment Department, Haryana against the order by which his application is ultimately declined.

Faced with this observation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to first avail her right of appeal provided under the Scheme.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case any such appeal is filed within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, the appellate authority shall not raise the issue regarding limitation and shall decide the appeal on merits.
