Through the instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to quash the impugned orders Annexure P-3 (09/04/2010) and Annexure P-4 (13/05/2010) vide which the benefit of increment @3% and grade pay granted in ACP scale has been denied by way of Administrative instructions contrary to the provisions of revised pay scale rules and the ACP rules and all other consequential orders vide which their pay has been fixed at lower stages than their juniors with further direction to grant increments @3% in the ACP scale and grade pay with all consequential benefits at par with their juniors.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submit that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 29.05.2018 (Annexure P-6), within some time bound manner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in his representation dated 29.05.2018 (Annexure P-6) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulations as well as in view of judgment passed by this Court in CWP No. 3922 of 2011, titled as **Narinder Pal Singh Arya and another vs. State of Haryana and others**; decided on 03.10.2016 (P-5), within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioners still feel aggrieved against any of the order(s) passed by the concerned authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies as well as to approach this Court.
