JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner (Maninderpal Singh) has competed for the post of Sub Station Attendant, advertised by the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Patiala on 20.12.2017 (**Annexure P-4**). He belongs to General Category and there were total 121 posts advertised in the said category. He possesses a full time regular Diploma in Electronics and Communications with Second Division, having secured 1669 marks out of 2800 marks as per the Certificate dated 09.05.2002 (**Annexure P-2**), issued by the Punjab State Board of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Chandigarh. The one of the alternate essential qualification for the post of Sub Station Attendant is a regular Diploma in Electronics and Communications with 60% (sixty *per cent*) marks, and hence, the petitioner has not been considered eligible, although in the selection process, he has secured marks placing him at Rank No. 92 in the Combined Merit List at **Annexure P-5**. Hence, the present writ petition.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition.
