The petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus for seeking a direction to extend the period of furlough for two weeks in terms of Section 3(1)(a) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 [for short 'the Act'].

The petitioner is lodged in Central Jail-I, Hisar. Initially, he was released on furlough on 16.08.2018 for 14 days on the ground of illness of his mother which was further extended upto 21.9.2018 vide order dated 30.8.2018. He has now prayed for further extension of the period of furlough on the same ground.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the record, I have found that the case set up by the petitioner for his release by way of extension of furlough is not made out because the period of furlough was already extended for three weeks i.e. upto 21.9.2018 while disposing of CWP No.21757 of 2018 on 30.8.2018.
