Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to count his work charge services rendered by him with the respondent-department from 01.11.1973 to 19.12.1976, for the purpose of pensionary benefits with all consequential benefits, in view of instructions issued by the Government from time to time as well as in view of the judgments passed by this Court.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice was made to the respondents on 22.07.2018 (P-2) but till date neither any reply to the said legal notice has been received nor any final order has been passed by the concerned Department. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide his legal notice (P-2), within some specified period.

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3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 22.07.2018 (P-2) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
