This petition is filed for seeking extension of parole, already granted to the petitioner, for a period of another three weeks.

In brief, the petitioner is suffering life imprisonment in case FIR No.361 dated 10.10.2009, registered under Sections 302/120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, Jhajjar, Haryana. He was released on agriculture parole on 09.08.2018 for 42 days and has to surrender before the Jail Authorities on 21.09.2018. Now the petitioner has prayed for extension of parole to be able to be by the side of his ailing mother, who is allegedly admitted in PGIMS, Rohtak, on the ground that there is no other male member in his family to look after his ailing mother. However, there is no averment in the present petition with regard to the aforesaid fact.

Be that as it may, I do not find any reason for extending the parole already granted to the petitioner beyond 21.09.2018. Thus, the present petition is hereby dismissed being denuded of any merit, though without any order as to costs.
