This is a petition praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant admission in B.Arch.Course.

We notice that the petitioner has not even approached the respondents in this regard. Consequently, we would not enter upon to exercise our jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India and issue a writ of mandamus. However, we grant liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents and make a detailed representation in accordance with the present petition within a period of three days from today. If such a course is adopted, the respondents shall look into the grievance of the petitioner made in the representation and pass a speaking order thereon within a period of two weeks thereafter.
