Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the 3rd ACP Scale for which he is entitled in the year 2009 and further revised the pension of the petitioner along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in the year 2009 petitioner was entitled for his 3rd ACP Scale and thereafter, the petitioner stood retired on December 03, 2014 on attaining the age of superannuation, but 3rd ACP Scale has not been granted to him. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide his legal notice dated August 14, 2017 (P-3) within some specified period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 to look

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into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated August 14, 2017 (P-3) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speakinder order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the order(s) passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
