This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that neither there is any inquiry against the petitioner nor he is involved in any FIR. Further, he states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-President, The Rampur Channa, Multipurpose Primary Co-operative Society Ltd, Rampur Chhanna, Tehsil Malerkotla, District Sangrur to consider and decide the legal notice dated 12.01.2016 (Annexure P-1).

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-President, The Rampur Channa, Multipurpose Primary Co-operative Society

Ltd, Rampur Chhanna, Tehsil Malerkotla, District Sangrur to consider and decide the legal notice dated 12.01.2016 (Annexure P-1) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible to him or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
