None appears for the petitioner. The order sheet reflects that none appeared for the petitioner on 14.09.2017 and last opportunity was granted and the matter was adjourned to 23.01.2018. Once again none appeared even on 23.01.2018. Even today none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned Senior counsel appearing for respondent No.3 contends that the prayer in the writ petition has become infructuous and stale in view of the fact that at the relevant time when the petition was filed in this Court, a writ in the nature of certiorari was sought to be issued for quashing the impugned order dated 23.08.2013 vide which petitioner was

declared ineligible for the post of Manager (Procurement) under SC category on the ground that he does not meet the requisite experience and the same was in violation of relevant applicable statutory rules. He further contends that during the pendency of the writ petition vide order dated 17.06.2015 (Annexure R-3/1), the petitioner has been promoted to the said post. In view of the said statement of the learned Senior counsel, the writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.
