By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought an issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondents to release the arrears of salary and other retiral benefits including gratuity, earned leave, leave encashment etc. along with interest @ 12% p.a. and to decide the representation dated 01.11.2017 (P-20).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though various representations including latest representation dated 01.11.2017 (P-20) were made to the respondents but till date no final order has been passed by the concerned authorities. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the above said representation (P-20), in a time bound manner.

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3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 01.11.2017 (P-20) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per service rules, regulations, instructions issued by the Government from time to time as well as observations made in ***CWP No. 3415 of 2017 captioned as Dial Singh vs. State of Punjab & ors. decided on 24.05.2018 (P-17)***, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
