Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought an issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the order dated 23.10.2017 (P-5) issued by respondent No.1 affecting recovery of Rs.1,55,538/- as well as to release the payment of Rs.1,55,538/- along with interest @ 18% p.a.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though various representations including latest representation dated 15.01.2018 (P-8) were made to the respondents but till date no conscious decision has been taken by the concerned authorities. He further submits that she feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the above said representation (P-8), in a time bound manner.

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3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 15.01.2018 (P-8) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
