Prayer made in the application for amendment of writ petition so as to implead Deputy Commissioner of Police (Traffic), who had passed the order dated 27.07.2018 (Annexure P10).

In view of the grounds taken in the application, the same is allowed, subject to all just exceptions. Amended writ petition and amended memo of parties are taken on record.

Present writ petition is for quashing the letter dated 27.07.2018 (Annexure P10) issued by respondent No.5-Deputy Commissioner of Police (Traffic), Gurugram, whereby memorandum of understanding dated 08.03.2018 (Annexure P6) between the parties has been terminated.

The main controversy involved in the case is regarding quashing of letter dated 27.07.2018 (Annexure P10) whereby memorandum of understanding dated 08.03.2018 (Annexure P6) between the parties had been terminated.

In view of above, present writ petition stands disposed of with the directions to respondent No.5-Deputy Commissioner of Police (Traffic), Gurugram to look into the above detailed application (Annexure P12) and take required action thereon expeditiously and preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Meanwhile, third party rights would not be created.
