Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought an issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the amount deducted from his CDS account along with interest and arrears as per the provisions of Additional Emoluments (Compulsory Deposit) Act, 1974.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a representation was made to the respondents on 17.04.2018 (P-7) but till date no response has been received. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the above said representation (P-7), in a time bound manner.

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3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 17.04.2018 (P-7) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid representation, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
