Pursuant to our previous order the petitioners have now furnished affidavits of Kabal Singh and Devender Singh wherein they have undertaken to deliver the possession to the Gram Panchayat within a period of one month and that they be permitted to harvest the crops.

We take the affidavits on record and noticing the undertaking to which the petitioners have bound themselves, we deem it appropriate to grant time to them to deliver the possession by 30.11.2018.

We make it clear that no further time would be granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners also states that the proceedings against the order adverse to the petitioners would also be withdrawn to give a quietus to the entire controversy.

In view of the above, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present with the following directions :-

- 1) That the petitioners will hand over the possession to the Gram Panchayat by 30.11.2018.
- 2) They would harvest the crops and none would obstruct the peaceful possession of the petitioners till 30.11.2018.
- 3) In case the petitioners violate the undertaking, they would be burdened with costs of Rs.1 lac each apart from other proceedings which we may initiate.
- 4) In case of such violation the Gram Panchayat would be at liberty to approach this Court in this regard.

Ordered accordingly.
