MAHESH GROVER, J. (Oral) :

Concededly an appeal against the order of Assistant Collector, determining the proceedings under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 is pending. The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondents are not initiating process on the said appeal, which is frustrating his right in the appeal. Apart from that, it is contended that a petition under Section 13A of the Act has already filed.

Be that as it may, since the appeal is pending, the petitioner has right to agitate and raise all objections that he seeks to raise in the present petition before the said authority. Therefore, without commenting upon merits of the issues before us, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition with direction to the Appellate Authority, to decide the appeal of the petitioner, within a period of four weeks, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Till that time, dispossession of the petitioner shall remain stayed.

It is made clear that in any case no un-toward adjournment shall be granted.
