 Learned counsel for respondent No.3 New India Insurance Company has agreed to grant ₹ 1,71,000/- (Rupees One Lakh and Seventy One Thousand Only), over and above the amount granted by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Kaithal. This amount is acceptable to the appellants as full and final settlement. Statements of learned counsel for the parties to this effect have been recorded separately.

 In view of the above amicable settlement between the parties, we direct respondent No.3-New India Insurance Company to produce a demand draft of ₹ 1,71,000/- within one month from today, before the learned Tribunal below, for onward disbursement of the settled amount to the appellants in proportion already arrived at by it, against proper receipt and identification, in accordance with law, failing which the enhanced amount shall carry an interest @ 12% per annum till payment.
