AJAY KUMAR MITTAL, J.

1. The prayer made in the writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuing direction to the respondents to reschedule the installments, as per RBI guidelines/instructions. It is further prayed that the respondent-Bank be directed not to take forcible possession of the building/shop.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the alternative remedies as may be available to her, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to her, in accordance with law.
