

Surender Vs. State of Haryana and Others

This petition is filed for seeking extension of parole. The petitioner is a life convict. He is lodged in Central Jail, Karnal. He had applied for parole as his son who is 6 years of age had to undergo operation grade III Tonsil in PGI, Chandigarh. The parole was granted on 06.09.2018 and the petitioner has to surrender on 26.09.2018.

It is not denied that the son of the petitioner was treated on 18.09.2018 but the necessity for seeking extension has arisen because the minor daughter of the petitioner is now suffering from Dengu and is admitted in ICU at PGI, Chandigarh. Notice in this case was issued on 24.09.2018 for today.

Mr. Rahul Mohan, DAG, Haryana, after seeking instructions from Bhagwan, ASI, has submitted that the daughter of the petitioner is actually admitted in ICU at PGI, Chandigarh suffering from Dengu.

Keeping in view aforesaid facts and circumstances, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted two weeks further parole to attend his ailing daughter. The extension of parole is granted on the bail bonds already furnished to the satisfaction of District Magistrate. However, petitioner is directed to surrender in jail after the completion of the parole.
