Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that total 20 posts of Excise Inspector have been increased to 35 posts as per the corrigendum dated 15.02.2017 and 12.09.2017. He further refers to the notice dated 08.08.2018 (Annexure P-4) whereby the candidates have been called for scrutiny of documents but the petitioner was not called for scrutiny of documents. Finally vide notice dated 13.09.2018 (Annexure P-5), candidates have been called for interview.

A perusal of the notice (Annexure P-5) shows that with regard to addition of 15 posts, no post is meant for OSP general category out of 12 posts reserved for general category and the last candidate in the general category has got 152 marks whereas the petitioner has secured 64 marks.

In the absence of any post in OSP general category, the petitioner has no right to be called for interview.

Dismissed.
