This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 27.01.2016 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2 whereby Market Committee, Kurali has been directed to deduct 50 % of salary of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition, however, foundation of the impugned order is the petition filed by respondent No.3-wife which was subsequently withdrawn. It is asserted that this factual position has already been explained to the authorities. However, the authorities have not taken a final decision on the issue.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-

Secretary, Punjab State Agriculture Marketing Board, Sector-65, SAS Nagar
to re-examine the matter and pass a fresh speaking order in the light of fresh
developments/circumstances within six weeks from the receipt of the
certified copy of the order.
