JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

It is averred that the petitioners, three in number, namely, *Rajinder Singh, Harjinderpal Singh and Jagdish Bhagat* (petitioner Nos. 1 to 3, respectively) joined as 'Vaccinator' in Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana, on 07.09.1984, 23.09.1981 & 05.03.1986, respectively. *Rajinder Singh* (petitioner No. 1) has since retired from the service on 31.01.2009. It is further averred that the Punjab Government had issued a notification dated 20.01.1989 (**Annexure P-1**), whereby it is ordered to prepare a joint seniority list by combining various categories (including the post of Vaccinator) of Health Department to Multipurpose Workers. The Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana (respondent No. 3), had not included the post of Vaccinator in joint seniority list of Multipurpose Workers, therefore, the petitioners served a legal notice dated 28.06.2018 (**Annexure P-4**) to frame a joint seniority list of all the Vaccinators and Health Workers, who have become Multipurpose Workers, as also to grant of all the arrears and retirement benefits.

Since no action has been taken so far, therefore, the petitioners have filed the instant petition.

At the very outset, counsel for the petitioners submits that in the petition, there are some typographical errors, therefore, prays for withdrawal of the present petition to file a fresh one with better particulars.

'Dismissed as withdrawn' with the liberty, as prayed for.
