JASWANT SINGH J.(Oral)

Two petitioners Jaspal Singh and Hardeep Singh were engaged as Lab Attendants by a privately managed aided college i.e. Babbar Akali Memorial Khalsa College, Garhsankar, District Hoshiarpur-respondent No.3 (affiliated to Punjab University, Chandigarh) on *ad hoc* basis against self-financing posts since 01.04.2012 and in the year 2008 respectively. They were paid consolidated salaries. Their services are claimed to have been regularised by the Management w.e.f. 01.4.2013 and 05.12.2015 respectively.

The claim is for grant of minimum pay scales on the ground that they are working against aided posts and as per the Rules/Regulations of the affiliating University-Punjab University as laid in Chapter VIII of University Calender dealing with affiliated colleges, they are entitled to the

grant of the claimed relief.

At the time of hearing realising that there is no material placed on record to substantiate that they are working on aided posts, counsel prays for withdrawing the petition to enable his clients to obtain required information under the RTI Act, and thereafter, if so advised, file fresh petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
