The petitioners have prayed for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to remove the tree, which has fallen on some portion of their house.

After notice, respondent No.2 has filed reply in which it is categorically mentioned that they are ready and willing to remove the tree in case a direction is issued by this Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and after taking into consideration the aforesaid facts and circumstances, am of the considered opinion that the need of the hour is that respondent No.2 should remove the tree which had fallen on some portion of the house of the petitioners. Therefore, a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to remove the tree within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
